

## Cancellation of Removal Supporting Evidence

1. Applicant's Birth Certificate
2. Birth Certificates of family (spouse and kids)
3. Marriage Certificate
4. Proof of physical presence the last 10 years. You must find physical evidence for every 90 days over the 10 years since your court case began.
  - a. Lease agreement and rent receipts
  - b. Pay stubs
  - c. Bank statements or agreements
  - d. Utility bills
  - e. Medical records/history
  - f. Insurance payments (health, auto, home)
  - g. Letters addressed to you at your U.S. residence
5. Tax returns for the past 10 years, including IRS transcripts.
6. Medical Evidence for any family member
  - a. Medical records from doctors, clinics, or specialists
  - b. Letter from the treating doctor (if you need a guide for this letter, we can provide one)
  - c. Copy of health insurance card
  - d. Prescriptions for any medications taken
7. School records for children
  - a. School history
  - b. Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Talented and Gifted (TAG) plan (if applicable)
  - c. Letters from the teachers or school officials
8. Family photos
9. Mortgage documents and property title or rental agreement
